Apply for Student Aid

- information about other income
- deduction and credit information

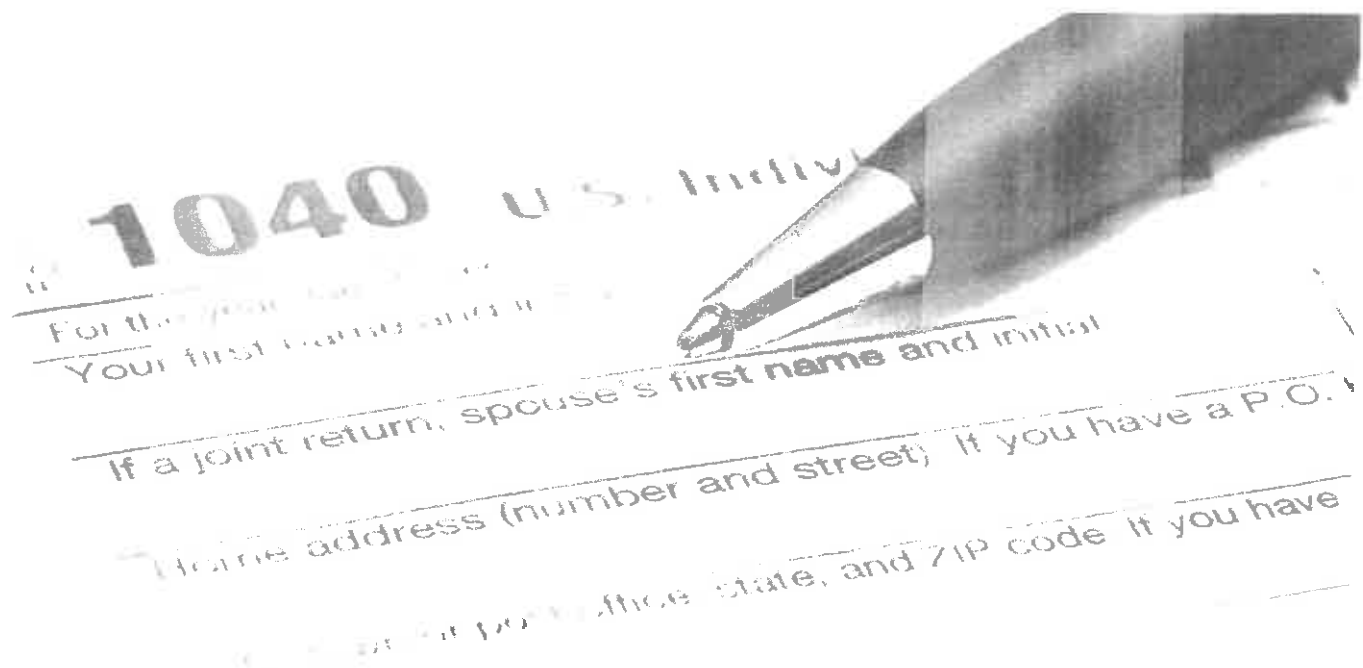

FREE TAX FILING

Claim Valuable Tax Credits

Find out automatically if you qualify for the **Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)**, Child Tax Credit, and others! And remember, if you are eligible for EITC and have not previously filed, you can still receive that money for up to three prior years.

Apply for Student Aid

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) form when you file your tax return. The FAFSA form is required for any student who is applying for financial aid distributed by the federal government and is used by colleges and universities to determine eligibility for federal student aid including grants, loans, and work-study.
